Health prevention measures are in place.					
Self screening at home for students & staff.					
Mandatory temperature screenings for visitors.					
Daily intensive cleaning and frequent cleaning and major focus on frequently used common areas.					
Limited visitor access.					
Masks at student and staff's discretion, but must comply with state and local mandates.					
Staff required to wear masks.					
Students required to wear masks.					
Scheduled hand cleaning for all students twice a day & sanitizing stations.					
Affected area is closed for deep cleaning (overnight or for one-day max).					
Self-health monitoring, prevention information and stay home if ill communication to all persons of the campus.					
Temperature screening required for staff & students, including bus riders. Bus riders will be required to pass temperature screenings to ride.					
Screening of affected grade level.					
Students & staff of that area will be advised to self-quarantine for 14 days.					
Screening for all students & staff.					
Self-health monitoring, prevention information and stay home if ill reminders sent to all parents of the district.					
Students in each affected grade level will self-contain and instruction will be streamed live to other classrooms as needed for instruction.					
All extra-curriculars will screen prior to practice.					
Entire campus closed for minimum three days.					
All students and staff of the campus may return if symptom free upon determination by the school district and health authorities.					
District-wide communication to staff/parents with health monitoring guidance.					
Transition to remote learning at the affected campus or district level.					
All CPISD facilities close for a minimum of 14 days.					
Disinfection of all facilities and school buses, district wide.					
All school facilities including playgrounds, track, and athletic facilities closed.					
Extracurricular activities are cancelled or rescheduled if possible for 14 days.					

This document is intended to serve as guidelines. Extreme conditions or circumstances may result in adjusting protocols.
